



"The 2022-23 Federal Budget has put public education last," said Correna Haythorpe, Australian Education Union Federal President.

"This budget is incredibly disappointing, but not surprising given the blatant preference for private schools and private VET providers that the Morrison Government continues to show at the expense of public schools and TAFEs."

The Federal Budget delivered by Treasurer Josh Frydenberg today contains the following:

- Funding for public schools has been reduced by \$559 million over the next 3 years
- Funding for private schools has increased by \$2.6 billion over the forward estimates
- No funding has been allocated for capital works in public schools
- No additional funding has been allocated
