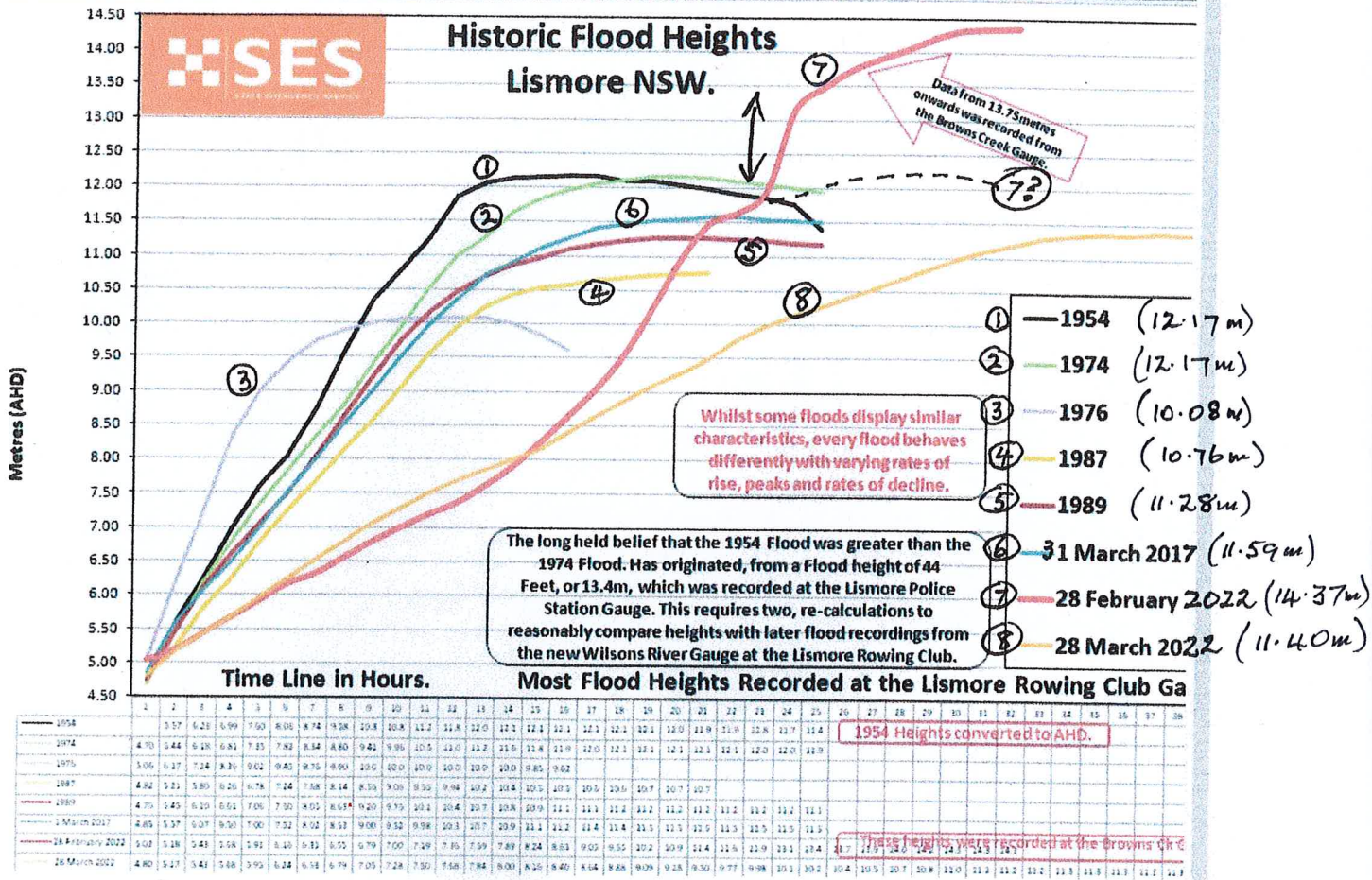

⑦? The path the 28/2/22 'MEGAFLOOD' MAY have taken if the flattening of the curve had followed the pattern of other floods BUT between midnight and 3am on 28/2/22 extremely heavy rain fell across the upper two-thirds of the catchment e.g. Dunoon recorded 195mm in the three hours and sixteen recording stations recorded an average of 106mm in the three hours. This deluge caused the sudden rise (see ↑) which has been likened to a flash flood on top of an already major flood.
