Just finally, what's your plan to stay in the Northern Rivers? What's your time frame in your plans right now?

Major Sue Hopper answered:

We've got outreach workers on the ground going door to door and they'll stay there as long as the funding lasts, basically.

Supplementary to this answer, The Salvation Army wishes to clarify that the 'funding' referred to by Major Hopper is the funds from The Salvation Army's Flood Appeal.

We also wish to reiterate that The Salvation Army Corps in flood effected areas will continue to operate and provide community focused recovery support for the long term.
