Application for an Authority to take fish for Aboriginal cultural fishing purposes

This form is to be used by an Aboriginal person wishing to apply for an Authority issued under Section 37(1)(d) of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* (the Act) for Aboriginal cultural fishing activities that are in extension to what the prescribed fishing rules allow.

Cultural fishing, as defined by the Act, means fishing activities and practices carried out by Aboriginal persons for the purpose of satisfying their personal, domestic or communal needs, or for educational, ceremonial of other traditional purposes, and which do not have a commercial purpose. For example, authorities may be issued to provide for additional amounts of fish to the current daily take or possession limits; the type of fishing equipment used; or fishing area access.

The applicant and all those authorised to participate in the fishing activity must be Aboriginal.

The Department of Primary Industries may provide details of this application to the NTSCORP Limited (the Native Title services provider for New South Wales and the Australian Capital Territory for Aboriginal Traditional Owners) and/or a Registered Native Title Body Corporate (RNTBC) to make comments pursuant to 24HA of the *Native Title Act (Cth)* 1993.

To avoid delays or refusal, this form should be completed in full with supporting information attached. It is important that all information is provided; as any change in dates, species, location or people involved in the collection may affect the conditions of the Authority or render the Authority invalid.
