This means you will not be able to fish in many more places.

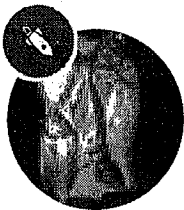

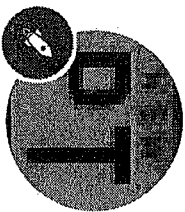

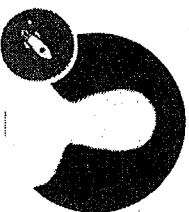
