Barangaroo sight lines inquiry to hold its first public hearing

A parliamentary committee inquiring into the Barangaroo 'sight lines' will hold its first public hearing on Tuesday 1 November 2022. This will be the first of the committee's two scheduled hearings.

The committee will hear evidence from the local Member for Sydney, Mr Alex Greenwich MP, as well as representative from community groups such as the Highgate Owners Corporation and the Millers Point Community Resident Action Group. The committee will also hear from Mr Karl Bitar, a former employee of Crown Resorts.

Committee Chair, the Hon Mark Latham MLC said: "The focus of the first day of hearings will be evidence from community groups and local advocates. The focus of our second hearing on 11 November 2022 will be the NSW Government's negotiations with Lendlease and Crown and the current dispute with Grocon. It is at that hearing that the committee will try to determine why the Barangaroo Delivery Authority appears to have sold the Sydney Harbour sight lines twice, to Lendlease-Crown and to Grocon?"
