The Standing Committee on State Development is undertaking an inquiry into allegations of impropriety against agents of City of Canterbury Bankstown Council.

The committee has been tasked with inquiring into and reporting on "matters in regards to the City of Canterbury Bankstown and the previous City of Bankstown Council including:

- (a) any matters relating to integrity, processes of Council, employees and elected officials of Council, and
- (b) any other related matter."

The first public hearing will be held on **21 December 2022 from 9.30 am**. The Mayor of the Council will give evidence. The hearing will be held in the Dixson Room at the State Library of New South Wales. Once available, hearing schedules will be published on the inquiry's [webpage](#).
