Re: Inquiry into the feasibility of undergrounding the transmission infrastructure for renewable energy projects – supplementary questions after 18 July 2023 hearing

Please find below my responses to the supplementary questions provided on Friday 21 July 2023.

1. Under what circumstances can a landholder refuse to grant permission for an overhead project such as HumeLink to impact their property? What are the likely consequences should that occur?

The Committee may wish to seek appropriate legal advice on this matter.

- (a) Are you in a position to describe the difference in the approval processes between a project within a NSW REZ and outside of a REZ (for example, in the vicinity of the HumeLink project in the Riverina area)?
 (b) Is it fair to say, in certain circumstances the requirements on a proponent of a repowable energy project, can be less when that project is outside of a NSW REZ.
 - (b) Is it fair to say, in certain circumstances the requirements on a proponent of a renewable energy project, can be less when that project is outside of a NSW REZ as opposed to within a NSW REZ?
