Besides a few minor issues with capitalisation suggestions for the names of policy processes, there are two substantive corrections I would like to request – arising from me slightly misstating student contribution amounts for arts fields.

I have indicated the requested corrections, which relate to the funding amounts highlighted in the attached table from the Commonwealth Government.

I appreciate that Hansard may not be able to make these changes, but thought I would ask given the technical nature and detail of the numbers I was trying to remember on the spot at the hear.

What happens there is that, as the universities enrol students from different disciplines, they consume their Commonwealth funding component up to their maximum. If you take, for example, a student doing law or economics or in the arts fields, the Commonwealth contribution is \$1,800, so you can enrol 27 of those sorts of students with the same impact on your funding envelope. Professional Pathway Psychology units of study are Behavioural Science units (with FOE codes starting with 0907) that contribute to a course of study that leads to a bachelor degree or honours degree in psychology with a course structure that makes it compulsory to study units relevant to professional registration as a psychologist by the Psychology Board of Australia, and the course of study represents a pathway to professional registration as a psychologist.
- 6. Professional Pathway Social Work units of study are Human Welfare Studies and Services units (with FOE codes starting with 0905) that contribute to courses of study that lead to a bachelor degree, honours degree or master's degree in:
 - a. social work accredited by the Australian Association of Social Workers;
 - b. youth work accredited by Youth Work Australia;
 - c. counselling accredited by the Australian Counsellors Association and/or the Psychotherapy and Counselling Federation of Australia; and
 - d. community work accredited by the Australian Community Workers Association.
