How much is being spent on maintenance and security in regards to Tomaree? Ms KATE WASHINGTON: The Tomaree Lodge — because it is such a special site, I think it is about \$1 million for the security on the site. The Hon. NATASHA MACLAREN- JONES: Security and maintenance? Ms KATE WASHINGTON: And on maintenance, it's about \$800,000. The Hon. NATASHA MACLAREN- JONES: Close to \$2 million all up. Ms KATE WASHINGTON: I beg your pardon? The Hon.
