Portfolio Committee No. 6 – Transport and the Arts, invites members of the community to contribute to its inquiry into the impact of the Rozelle Interchange.

Committee Chair, Ms Cate Faehrmann, said: "Over the past couple of months, the opening of Rozelle Interchange has created difficulties for commuters coming from many parts of Sydney, particularly inner west residents and those travelling over the Iron Cove and Gladesville bridges."

Ms Faehrmann continued: "This inquiry will examine the planning, design, and development of the interchange, its impact on traffic flow and public transport, as well as social, economic and environmental impacts on the local community. It will also examine the issue of asbestos contamination of Rozelle Parklands. In addition, the committee is committed to identifying solutions that will ease the congestion and gridlock."
