

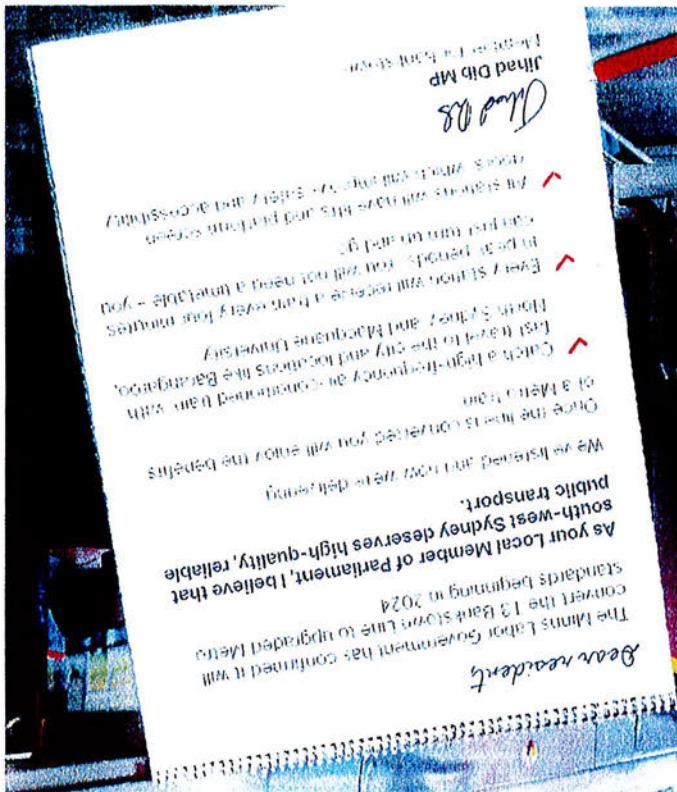

Why do we need to do this?

The Bankstown Line is almost 130 years old, which means trains often run late or are cancelled. It also makes it more difficult for the network to recover when things go wrong.

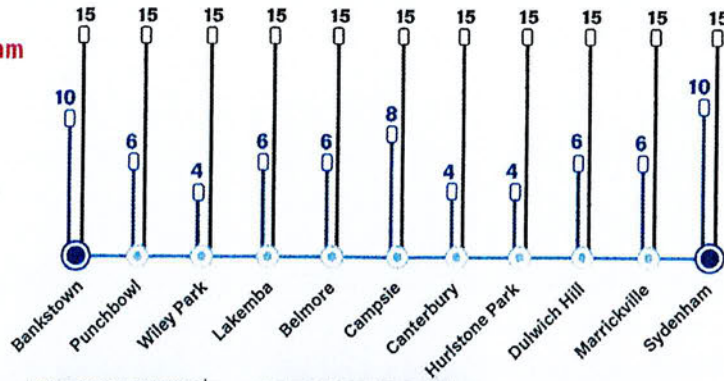
Connecting the Bankstown line to the City and Northwest metro line will provide more train services to our community. It will improve the reliability of the entire Sydney rail network, by freeing up capacity on the City Circle.

Once complete, all stations between Bankstown and Sydenham will receive 15 services per hour at the peak in both directions.

This means you can catch a train every four minutes. There is potential for even greater frequency in future.

Will the Bankstown line have to close?

To deliver the Metro, the 13 Bankstown line will need to close for up to 12 months from mid-late 2024. Services on the new Metro will begin in 2025.

We understand that disruption is difficult and have worked hard to reduce the shutdown. That is why our plan is to deliver the line as quickly as possible, with minimal disruption to residents and passengers.

The Liberals planned to close the train line for 15 months or more. The Minns Labor Government will reopen the line after 12 months, meaning you will have access to Metro services sooner.

We are completing as much work as possible before the line closes.

How will I travel when the line is closed?

The Minns Labor Government is working hard to minimise disruption to our community. That is why during the shutdown, we will deliver a high quality, comprehensive Temporary Transport Plan.

Our plan will be much better than just replacing the train line with buses. Instead, you will have options to connect to other train services, buses, light rail, and public and active transport.

This will include safe, well-lit, stops that provide travel information and protection from the weather.

We will make sure you have all the information you need to make travel as easy as possible before the line closes next year.

You will have real choices to travel conveniently and cheaply during the shutdown.
