In relation to the evidence given by me at the hearing on Friday 23 February 2024 regarding the publication of a safety alert (page 63 of the uncorrected transcript), I have become aware that my statement was factually incorrect and I would like to correct the record.

At the hearing I stated that "Following assessment of that, we formed a view that a safety alert would be appropriate, so we put an alert out to all operators specifically around managing hot temperature conditions."

I referred to the publication of the safety alert in the past tense, however the safety is currently undergoing consultation with the directly involved parties. It will be become public following that process in approximately 2 weeks.

The factually correct statement should have been "Following assessment of that, we formed a view that a safety alert would be appropriate, so we will be putting out an alert to all operators specifically around managing hot temperature conditions."
