Please see below the response to the QON in relation to TOD community consultation.

- The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the Department) commenced initial briefings with all councils impacted by the Transport Oriented Development Program (TOD) in December 2023. Between January and March 2024, the Department held numerous briefings with councils and councillors and sought their feedback on the TOD program on behalf of their communities.
- In the eight accelerated precincts, community and stakeholders will have an opportunity to review and have their say on the details of the state-led rezonings through formal consultation and engagement processes with engagement on the first precincts to start in the second quarter of 2024.
