### ROZELLE INTERCHANGE INQUIRY– PUBLIC HEARING

Portfolio Committee No. 6 – Transport and the Arts will hold its second and third public hearings on Tuesday 23 April 2024 and 3 May 2024 as the committee continues its inquiry into the impact of the Rozelle Interchange.

At its second hearing, the committee will hear from Transurban, John Holland and CPB Contractors, as well as representatives from local councils and community groups, including active transport and environmental advocacy organisations.

At its third hearing, the committee will receive evidence from the Minister for Roads, Hon John Graham MLC, alongside representatives from Transport for New South Wales.

The Committee Chair, Ms Cate Faehrmann MLC, said: 'There has been widespread public interest in this issue. While the first hearing and public forum provided opportunity for individuals and local communities to express their views, these next two hearings not only aim to build on that evidence by hearing from advocacy organisations but explore other aspects of the project by hearing from those involved in the planning, design and delivery of the Rozelle Interchange.'

The Chair continued: 'In particular, the committee is looking forward to speaking with the Hon John Graham MLC, Minister from Roads, and officials from Transport for New South Wales'.
