REVIEW INTO THE DESIGN AND BUILDING PRACTITIONERS ACT 2020 AND THE RESIDENTIAL APARTMENT BUILDINGS (COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT POWERS) ACT 2020

The NSW Legislative Council's Public Accountability and Works Committee has commenced a review into the *Design and Building Practitioners Act 2020* and the *Residential Apartment Buildings (Compliance and Enforcement Powers) Act 2020*.

Ms Abigail Boyd MLC, Chair of the committee said: 'As required by the legislation, this review will consider the functions exercised or delegated by the Secretary of the Department of Customer Service. It will also examine whether the policy objectives of the *Design and Building Practitioners Act 2020* and the *Residential Apartment Buildings (Compliance and Enforcement Powers) Act 2020* remain valid and whether the terms of the statutes are effective for securing these goals.'
