
How the traffic modelling was manipulated



- The project proposed in the business case and EIS, for which planning approval was sought and given, was Project A.
- The traffic modelling and forecasts in the business case and EIS were based on a substantially different proposal: Project X.
- The environmental, health and social impacts described in the EIS are based on an assessment of the fictitious Project X.
- The EPA Act requires that the project assessed in the EIS be the same as the project proposed in the EyS.
- The EIS did not describe the forecast traffic and other impacts of the proposed project (Project A), as required by the EPA Act.

• It is **Project A** that was delivered.
