**HUMANS:CONNECTING's** Supplementary Submission lodged on 17 February 2025 referred to the creation of [Lonely-EU](#), a project that is bringing together science and policy makers on providing evidence-based policy solutions throughout the European Union. Our submission offered Lonely-EU as a model for which the Committee may want to consider developing in New South Wales.
