## MODERN SLAVERY COMMITTEE TO HOLD HEARING IN GRIFFITH

## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE 17 June 2025

The NSW Parliament's Modern Slavery Committee will travel to Griffith on Thursday 19 June 2025 to hold its third hearing as part of its inquiry into modern slavery risks faced by temporary migrant workers in rural and regional New South Wales.

The committee will hear from local councils, advocacy and community groups and health organisations.

Dr Joe McGirr MP, Committee Chair stated: 'The committee is travelling to Griffith this week to hear directly from those who provide support to and advocate for victim-survivors of modern slavery in the region.'

'The committee appreciates the time taken by local stakeholders to provide evidence to the committee.'
