Questions from Ms Cate Faehrmann MLC

Building and construction fire safety

- (1) At what point in a structural fire does the Building Commission NSW (BCNSW) suggest that the provision 'egress' via a fire door is no longer a requirement under the National Construction Code (NCC)?
- (2) Is the position of the BCNSW one which is agreed by the fire authorities given that they are both subject matter experts in fire safety and have specific requirements in complex rescue environments?
- (3) Section 109 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment (Development Certification and Fire Safety) Regulation states that a person must not, without lawful excuse, interfere or obstruct a fire exit door or the operation of fire door in providing egress. If, as the fire authorities warn, a fire door with bolts was to be rendered inoperable from activated bolts during a fire, how are those circumstances considered compliant with EP&A Regs?
- (4) Previously the BCNSW has cited that bolts could be activated at 200 degrees during a structural fire, making early intervention from firefighters fairly important. But for occupants who live in rural fire district, outside of Fire and Rescue NSW's jurisdiction and without a legislated guarantee of emergency response, what implications could this have on community safety in aged care facility for example?

Self locking fire doors

(5) In the last budget estimates in Feb-Mar 2025, in your answer to supplementary questions you stated that the Building Commission is actively considering fire fighters concerns regarding fireproof self locking doors. How have the Building Commissioner responded to these concerns?

Palantir has also been working with the Trump administration, with ICE Agents to target people subject to their mass deportation plans. Palantir has recently been found to have been collecting confidential NHS patient data, following a contract with the UK government, raising immense privacy concerns. In this meeting, what was discussed?
- (177) Just a few weeks after your meeting with Palantir, they were listed as a supplier in the NSW Government's supplier portal. Their profile was updated on 23 June 2025, indicating they offer platforms such as Foundry, AIP, Apollo, and Gotham, and position themselves as providing advanced AI, cloud, and analytics technology. - (377) How many times has the Minister visited Junee Correctional Centre since 31 March 2025?
- (378) Have you visited Junee Correctional Centre since being appointed Minister for Corrections?

Whole-of-Centre Lockdowns

- (407) On assaults, It was mentioned tactical response teams. Could the department provide numbers on how many times those tactical teams were deployed in the past 12 months and the outcomes?
- (408) Staff suspensions were put at around 79 with most on full pay. Could you provide the total cost to the Corrections budget of paying suspended staff over the last year?

Deaths in Custody (Daily Telegraph, 25 August 2025)

- (409) The Daily Telegraph reported on 25 August that there have been 10 deaths in custody of Aboriginal people this year. Can the Department confirm whether that figure is correct?
