E.g., "person complained of being physically assaulted outside Synagogue" would be sufficient detail and an indication next to the summary of what charge were laid in relation to the incident if a charge/s was.

PREVIOUS ANSWER

No. Retrieving that information for each matter would require manual review of entries that is not feasible within the timeframe required to respond to the supplementary questions.

ADDITIONAL ANSWER

Operation Shelter began on 11 October 2023. During that time, a manual spreadsheet was maintained documenting all Shelter-related incidents that have occurred. The term 'incidents' encompasses Events, Intelligence Reports and Charges as recorded in COPS.

The spreadsheet was internally developed during the early stages of Operation Shelter to track incidents flagged as 'Shelter-related'. Given the frequent rotation of officers managing the Operation Shelter, the consistency and veracity of incident recording varied over time.

The NSW Police Force has reviewed all incidents, and a preliminary review suggests that a significant number of incidents do not meet the criteria for antisemitism; defined as prejudice or hatred directed at individuals based on their Jewish faith or cultural identity. In some cases, incidents were incorrectly categorised as "Antisemitic" solely on the basis that the person reporting or the victim was Jewish.

The below table outlines a brief summary of the facts of each of these matters. It also provides examples of some of the mis-categorisation and 38 duplications of incidents (highlighted in red).

12-Oct-23	Official Instagram account "nswjbd - NSW Jewish Board of Deputies" received threatening messages.
13-Oct-23	Three men performed Nazi salutes and actions outside the Sydney Jewish Museum
13-Oct-23	Report of Star of David graffiti.
13-Oct-23	Three men performed Nazi salutes and actions outside the Sydney Jewish Museum

15-Oct-23	Two Jewish victims were walking and speaking Hebrew encountered a group of Middle Eastern individuals. One man, wearing a Palestinian flag, spat in their direction without verbal interaction.
15-Oct-23	Young persons were reported to be yelling comments in relation to Hitler towards a Jewish House Location.
16-Oct-23	Antisemitic graffiti located within Westfield stairwell.
16-Oct-23	Threatening email sent to Jewish Board of Education. The email stated, 'Stop the inhuman torture you are doing in Palestine, otherwise you will have to pay a heavy price inshallah'.
16-Oct-23	A Jewish business owner advertised a job on Seek.com. and applicant was interviewed by phone. After a delayed response and explained it was due to Chabbat, Hamad sent abusive, antisemitic messages, referencing violence and hate speech.
17-Oct-23	Person was charged two days priors for displaying Nazi flag nearby a synagogue, additional report he drove his vehicle through suburbs that were in breach of his bail conditions, no flag was seen displayed during secondary report.

17-Oct-23	Victim is of Jewish faith, whilst walking in Bondi Junction a male began aggressively yelling racial slurs towards him, he then pointed his finger in a gun-like shape and mimicked a shooting action towards the victim.
17-Oct-23	Male entered a Pharmacy wielding a sledgehammer, made threatening remarks to staff over medication. His behaviour escalated to verbal abuse and threats involving antisemitic language. He attempted to assault the pharmacy owner and later punched a bystander who intervened.
18-Oct-23	A public Instagram page promoted support for Israeli victims of the Israel/Palestine conflict. Another account responded with hostile messages, including anti-Semitic remarks and praise for Hitler.
18-Oct-23	Australia Israel Chamber of Commerce received a phone call which said, "Dirty filthy Israelis" and then disconnected the call.
19-Oct-23	A white Volkswagen Ute drove past Moriah College, the male driver yelled "F*** the Jews"
20-Oct-23	A Jewish TV personality received abusive messages after posting an Instagram story expressing concern for Israeli victims of the conflict. Over 30 offensive messages were sent via Instagram, text, and email, including threats and hate speech targeting her faith and public stance.
20-Oct-23	Male using Facebook posted anti-Semitic comments on a public protest page. The posts incited harm against Jewish people and were visible to all users.
21-Oct-23	Male observed outside a Bondi synagogue shouting anti-Semitic remarks and spitting from his vehicle.
21-Oct-23	Palestine Action Group held an action in Sydney, phrases or chants heard prompted 16 email complaints to NSW Police, alleging the language incited violence
21-Oct-23	The victim posted violent anti-Semitic comments on Facebook, leading to criminal charges. The following evening, the victim received a threatening message stating, "Nazi scum, we're on our way to you."
22-Oct-23	WhatsApp group for Jewish university students discussing the Israel/Palestine conflict was disrupted by a person who joined via an invite link. The POI made homophobic and anti-Semitic remarks.
22-Oct-23	Male charged for verbally abusing a Jewish family, shouting anti-Semitic remarks and engaging in a hostile confrontation
23-Oct-23	Persons were at Bondi Beach when they overheard a nearby group making loud statements "Allah Akbar" and "F*** the Jews", and further antisemitic comments.
26-Oct-23	Police received information regarding an Instagram post featuring a fabricated quote attributed to Hitler, accompanied by his image and antisemitic materials.
26-Oct-23	An online post was sighted with quote attributed to Adolf Hitler on Instagram, alongside antisemitic captions. The post did not contain direct threats or incitement to violence.
26-Oct-23	A victim's decoration was defaced with political messages of Pro-Palestine nature and glued to the ground.
26-Oct-23	A letter containing offensive and threatening language was received at the Sydney Jewish Museum, addressed to an employee.

26-Oct-23	A Jewish community member with public pro-Palestine views was approached by an unknown male while walking in Double Bay. The individual allegedly struck the victim's shoulder and made aggressive verbal remarks, including personal insults and political slogans.
26-Oct-23	A truck displaying images of kidnapped individuals in Israel was parked on Pitt Street, Sydney. A male approached the vehicle and made loud, offensive remarks, including political commentary and personal insults, some in Arabic.
28-Oct-23	A Jewish individual encountered a "Free Palestine" rally poster and attempted to remove it. He was confronted by another person who made hostile remarks, leading to a verbal exchange. The situation escalated when the individual was threatened and later physically assaulted by three unknown persons.
28-Oct-23	Security guards stationed outside Bondi Synagogue observed a driver shout an offensive antisemitic remark and recalled hearing a political slogan. Both guards stated the driver made a gesture resembling a Nazi salute.
29-Oct-23	Victims attended a Pro-Israel related public assembly, whilst on a ferry a male exiting the ferry directed hostile comments toward the group.
30-Oct-23	A shop employee at "Jews for Jews" received a disturbing phone call from an unknown female caller who made offensive and antisemitic remarks.
31-Oct-23	Staff member at Moriah College received a direct message on the school's Instagram account containing antisemitic material.
31-Oct-23	Witness reported seeing an unknown person climb a flagpole and remove an Israeli flag before decamping with the flag.
02-Nov-23	An approved art installation at Bondi Beach displaying images of Jewish hostages was disrupted when two individuals removed posters from the display. A confrontation followed between the organisers and the individuals.
03-Nov-23	Residents reported ongoing harassment and racial abuse from neighbour, including antisemitic threats and intimidation. Conflicting and contradicting version reported to police.
04-Nov-23	Unknown persons have used paint to deface several locations in Waverly Council with Pro-Palestine material
05-Nov-23	Crime Stoppers report of online post containing an unknown male speaking in support of Hamas in Sydney.
05-Nov-23	Anti-Semitic posters stuck on street signs along Southern Cross Drive Alexandria.
06-Nov-23	Person associated to Australian Jewish Association received a threatening letter containing hostile language targeting the Jewish community and included direct threats to the recipient.
06-Nov-23	Two Nazi Hitler posters affixed to overpass in Brighton Le-Sands.
07-Nov-23	Person associated to Australian Jewish Association reported online harassment. Posts included photos of his vehicle and registration and personal address.
09-Nov-23	A security guard at Moriah College reported hearing the passenger of a passing vehicle shout "Allahu Akbar" near the school entrance.
09-Nov-23	A security guard at Moriah College reported verbal abuse from a passing driver.

09-Nov-23	A business owner reported harassment, including anonymous calls, social media abuse, and in-person remarks linked to her Israeli Defence Force background. A photo of her in IDF uniform was shared online with calls to boycott her business.

11-Nov-23	Unknown individuals vandalised the exterior wall of a residential property with antisemitic graffiti. Further additional graffiti located nearby.
11-Nov-23	Police observed a vehicle displaying a flag resembling that of the proscribed Palestinian Islamic Jihad Movement.
11-Nov-23	Male attended Goldstein Reserve in Coogee shouted antisemitic remarks towards a Jewish Community gathering displaying the Star of David.
12-Nov-23	Two persons vandalised the front entrance of Surry Hills Restaurant, including glued images of deceased children and sprayed anti-Israel messages.

11-Jun-24	A male was captured on CCTV footage drive past the Moriah College and directly look into the camera, raise his left arm off the steering wheel and displayed a 'Seig Heil' sign/ gesture.
12-Jun-24	A male drove his motor vehicle to the Jewish War Museum and graffiti's the war memorial wall with the word 'Genocide'.

12-Jun-24	Unknown persons have graffitied the Fearnley Grounds in Centennial Park with a number of anti-Semitic slogans. Including references to the Jewish Holocaust and Hitler.
15-Jun-24	Pro-Palestine graffiti reported on Police Station exterior.
06-Jul-24	A male was talking on Anzac Parade, Maroubra and was approached by 4 young persons on bicycles. As the young person's rode past the male, they yelled out "Heil Hitler "and continued to ride away.
10-Jul-24	A pair of friends were parked on Gould Street, Bondi when a motor vehicle with females inside drove past them twice playing Arabic music really loud, using their mobile phones to record and yelled out to them "F*** Israel".
25-Jul-24	A male contacted the NSW Greens State Office via phone and was extremely hostile, threatening and used antisemitic language towards staff. The male is then captured on CCTV wearing a 'Ned Kelly' style helmet and firearm in his holster. He uses his phone to film himself and post on Facebook, his graffiti on the front glass door, in red spray paint, "White supremacist, 'Ahmed Ibn Abi Sulayman Said If Someone says our prophet is black! Kill Him! Hadith p 375 Islam (is) White Supremacy Slavery Rape Genocide Never disrespectful our war memorial Greens are enemy of Australia".
11-Aug-24	A Jewish man witnessed outside the Adath Synagogue a unknown male to raise his right hand to form a Nazi salute towards him and laughed.
22-Aug-24	A Jewish male received 2x voice recordings from a male on Snapchat stating, "free Palestine", "g** the jews ya f*****" and "hail Hitler"
26-Aug-24	A male took a photograph whilst going down an escalator of a Jewish male wearing Kippah. The male uploaded the image to Instagram and included text "(Gotta Catch 'Em All) Hitler failed" alongside a laughing/ sweating emoji.
10-Sep-24	A male called and left voicemails to the Central Synagogue in Bondi. The messages contain repeated threats of violence, terrorism, and hate speech directed at Jewish individuals and institutions. Threatening to bomb synagogues, commit murder, and carry out terrorist attacks. He referenced past violent incidents and expressed intent to harm others and himself.
10-Sep-24	Two males parked their vehicle directly in front of the Central Synagogue, Bondi Junction. One male was seen to be taking photos of the venue and the stairs that lead to the Rabbi's office. The 2nd male appeared to be nervous, repeatedly swearing and sped off at high speed away from the venue.
12-Sep-24	Unknown persons graffitied a wall on a construction site which was visible to the public in Arncliffe. It read "Since 1948 Israel Terror State".
14-Sep-24	A female received a note in an envelope posted to her mail after she'd posted a pro- Israel statement on Instagram. The note read, "You should be ashamed of everything you've posted on Instagram. STOP IT NOW."
15-Sep-24	2x unknown persons attended the Archibald Memorial Fountain in Hyde Park and used red dye to the water into a red colour. They also attached an adhesive white paper banner on the fountain in red text which read "these massacres".

13-Oct-24	A known Israeli bakery, operated by a prominent member of the Jewish community, whom also has a public profile and is a well-known TV Chef received a threatening note displaying the Star of David to mark events in Gaza and Yom Kippur. The incident, involving red upside-down triangles and a handwritten "Be Careful" message.
14-Oct-24	A female person attracted police's attention by shouting at passers-by while brandishing a metal object resembling an axe or machete, along with open scissors. She denim shorts marked with swastikas, and carried bags similarly decorated with Nazi symbols.
19-Oct-24	A male allegedly made a threatening "shotgun hand gesture" from a vehicle towards 2x Jewish male security workers, outside Emanuel Temple Synagogue in Woollahra.
19-Oct-24	A security guard was standing out the front of The Great Synagogue, Sydney when an unknown male walked past and yelled antisemitic abuse, and spat towards the security staff.
20-Oct-24	5x males were involved in a failed arson attempt at Curley Lewis Brewery, followed by a successful arson at Lewis' Continental Kitchen, Bondi. The group wore disguises and used accelerants, with 1 x male orchestrating the plan and offering payment.
21-Oct-24	The male exhibits extremist and antisocial behaviour. He allegedly distributed a hate-filled note to neighbours and possesses concerning material on his phone, including offensive literature and protest imagery. Police are alarmed by his fixation on HM King Charles III, especially given the monarch's presence in the country and the male's proximity to key infrastructure. The male is also suspected in a targeted arson attack on a homeless individual, with evidence of fire-related paraphernalia and videos found in his residence, indicating a disturbing obsession with fire.
22-Oct-24	A young male used mulberries to paint swastikas and shout white supremacist slogans.
23-Oct-24	The Mayor of Northern Beaches Council reported receiving threatening comments in relation to the Gaza conflict on Instagram. The comments further included and escalated when the male, under another account, posted a message implying a future confrontation at a public event.
27-Oct-24	A man wearing an anti-Israel shirt approached another male near Bondi Beach. When the individual took a photo of the shirt, the man responded aggressively, squaring his shoulders and appearing ready for confrontation.
28-Oct-24	Antisemitic graffiti found located in the toilets of Harley Place, Bondi Junction.
29-Oct-24	A female of Jewish faith was standing outside the Moriah College, Queens Park when a male made eye contact with her and yelled, "long live Palestine. F*** the Jews".
16-Nov-24	Unknown persons have vandalised a motor vehicle, causing extensive damage. Antisemitic and offensive graffiti—including slurs, a Nazi swastika, and political slogans were painted across multiple panels. The rear windscreen was smashed, the roof caved in, and sugar-like granules were poured into the fuel tank.
21-Nov-24	2 males travelled through Woollahra, targeting vehicles and properties with hateful graffiti referencing "PKK" and anti-Israel slogans. The area, known for its Jewish community, saw multiple cars and buildings vandalised. Their actions culminated in the arson of a motor vehicle, causing its destruction and damage to a nearby vehicles. The incident involved deliberate hate-motivated offences and references to a listed terrorist organisation, PKK, linked to Kurdish separatist movements.

21-Nov-24	A female staff member at Jewish Care in Woollahra received five harassing phone calls from a male caller. In the final voicemail, he expressed hateful views toward the Jewish religion, using offensive language and slurs. He ended the message with a violent threat targeting individuals wearing religious attire.
21-Nov-24	In Bondi Junction, a local Jewish male heard antisemitic slurs shouted by a unknown man walking nearby with loud music. The male confronted him, who responded with hostile and threatening remarks, including "We hate Jews" and a claim that "the Lebo's are coming to waste you." The incident, captured on CCTV, ended with the male making an obscene gesture before walking away.
23-Nov-24	At Bondi Beach a man standing with his family was verbally threatened by another male who shouted an offensive political statement. The male reacted by flicking water, the aggressor confronted him aggressively, made repeated death threats, and mimicked stabbing motions with his fist.
29-Nov-24	A male repeatedly yelled out in public "I hate Jews." and raised his left arm at a 45-degree angle with his palm flat facing towards the ground in a nazi salute and smiled numerous times.
30-Nov-24	During a Bar Mitzvah at North Bondi SLSC, a witness observed a group of around ten men of Middle Eastern appearance loitering near the venue. They shouted antisemitic and anti-Israel slurs. One individual male, threw a stone at the SLSC building, striking its beachfront wall.
08-Dec-24	The owner of a Kosher (Jewish bakery) received a threatening phone call on their personal number. After offering to provide the shop's contact details, the caller responded with profanity, political slogans, and a direct threat.
08-Dec-24	A young male called the Golds Sydney Jewish Books, the owner of store answered the phone, and the person said, 'F*** the Jews, f*** the Jews, f*** the Jews' and ended the phone call.
10-Dec-24	A male displayed an Israeli flag as like a curtain/ covering from inside his unit that could be seen by the public. 4x eggs were thrown directly at the window.
10-Dec-24	Security Officers at The Great Synagogue, Sydney observed a male wearing what appeared to be a 'Furry wolf' mask. That male turned to them and made an arm gesture with his right arm which they took to be a nazi salute.
11-Dec-24	Two male offenders vandalised properties on Magney Street, Woollahra, spray-painting anti-Semitic messages on walls, a vehicle, and the footpath. One then set fire to a red Corolla before both fled toward Harbourview Park.
11-Dec-24	Both a male and female offender vandalised properties in Woollahra, spray-painting anti-Semitic messages on walls, a vehicle, and the footpath. One then set fire to a vehicle before both fled toward Harbourview Park.
11-Dec-24	Graffiti "Jew Pig" located in Manly carpark.
12-Dec-24	6x \$50 notes had been tampered and graffitied with antisemitic, including Nazi Symbols, and Swastikas.
12-Dec-24	Arts Factory, Byron Bay, received an anti-sematic phone call from an unknown male.
13-Dec-24	Anti-sematic graffiti located at the Kingsford Juniors - light rail stop.

14-Dec-24	6x \$50 notes had been tampered and graffitied with antisemitic, including Nazi Symbols, and Swastikas.
15-Dec-24	Police attended Montefiore Nursing Home, Randwick to conduct patrols in relation to Operation Shelter.
15-Dec-24	Witnesses were at a lawful demonstration when they heard 2x males yell out antisematic chants towards them.
15-Dec-24	A male wearing a Kippah was returning to his vehicle when a male drove past him and yelled out "Are you a f***ing jew" and looked at the male and motioned with his hand across his neck. The male interpreted that as a throat slitting motion.
16-Dec-24	A worker alerted a publicly Jewish figure of vandalism to her home. Black spray paint on a cement wall near displayed anti-Semitic remarks including a Nazi symbol.
16-Dec-24	An envelope received by mail was brought to staff from the Emanuel Synagogue, Woollahra. The back of the envelope was found to contain antisemitic messages written, including hateful and discriminatory nature, derogatory remarks about Jewish people and references to religious condemnation.
16-Dec-24	Graffiti with anti-Islamic messages and silver Stars of David was reported under a train bridge at Hector St and Wellington Rd in Sefton.
20-Dec-24	Police were performing Operation Shelter related taskings outside the Emanuel Synagogue.
20-Dec-24	6x \$50.00 notes defaced, displayed Anti-Semitic images.
20-Dec-24	A letter marked "PRIVATE" was delivered to the Jewish Museum in Darlinghurst. The back of the envelope contained multiple anti-Semitic messages.
21-Dec-24	Graffiti located Beacon Hill, described as; a yellow spray paint with words "James", "migakim" and "vet" a symbol described as a smiley face wearing a crown, 3x Nazi swastika symbols and what appears to be male genitalia.
23-Dec-24	A \$50 defaced with swastika sign on the top and antisemitic writing on the bottom of note.
27-Dec-24	A carved stone map displayed on an interior wall of Mez Club in Byron Bay surrounds a large booth and table. The map features etched outlines of countries, but the name "Israel" appears to have been deliberately scratched off.
28-Dec-24	Police alerted to located youths graffitiing nazi symbols near Maroubra Beach Carpark.
28-Dec-24	A male received an email that contained a hostile and antisemitic message, containing threats against Jewish people. It denied the Holocaust, uses slurs, glorifies Hitler, and predicts future violence.
28-Dec-24	Graffiti spray-painted on the road outside two properties. The messages included antisemitic content.
29-Dec-24	Police attended a park in Cremorne after receiving a report of swastikas painted on a North Sydney Council truck parked in the carpark. Three red swastikas, incorrectly shaped, were found on the rear tray of the vehicle.
01-Jan-25	Offensive graffiti was discovered on the front window of Jo Haylen MP's office in Marrickville. The graffiti included the phrase "NAZI GRUB" and a Nazi symbol, spraypainted in black.

04-Jan-25	Two individuals were targeted with threatening hand gestures resembling a firearm by a passenger in a red Mazda while leaving Chabad North Shore in St Ives.
05-Jan-25	A 15-year-old male was seen publicly displaying a homemade Nazi flag and performing Nazi salutes.
06-Jan-25	Antisemitic graffiti was discovered on a vehicle parked in Queens Park.
06-Jan-25	\$6,500 AUD in defaced \$50 notes bearing anti-Semitic messages and swastikas was discovered at a security company in Beresfield. The cash originated from a \$25,000 bundle supplied by a bank in Haymarket.
06-Jan-25	Anti-Semitic graffiti was reported on a mural wall in Sydenham.
07-Jan-25	A post to the Meadowbank Community Group Facebook page of anti-Israel graffiti at a Meadowbank construction site.
10-Jan-25	Anti-Semitic, anti-Israel and Pro-Palestine graffiti was spray-painted across nearly every wall of a Synagogue in Newtown. Messages included slurs, swastikas, and references to Palestine and Hitler. Police discovered a green fuel container and torn paper bag nearby.
10-Jan-25	Unknown offenders vandalised a wall in Queens Park with anti-Semitic graffiti and splashed pink paint on nearby vehicles.
10-Jan-25	A passerby noticed antisemitic graffiti scrawled in black marker over a communist manifesto poster at a phone booth in Marrickville.
10-Jan-25	Security guards were verbally confronted outside a Jewish Synagogue in Newtown, expressing pro-Palestinian views and accusing them of supporting genocide.
10-Jan-25	A primary school in Lewisham was accessed unlawfully, resulting in vandalism across four classrooms. Including antisemitic graffiti and burn damage to a teddy bear and photo.
11-Jan-25	Two persons vandalised the Newtown Synagogue. One person spray-painted ten red swastikas and a "Z" symbol across the synagogue's brick fence, while the other person poured a clear liquid near the entrance and ignited it, causing a small fire and explosion.
11-Jan-25	Police attended a Skate Park following a report to Council regarding antisemitic graffiti on one of the ramps.
11-Jan-25	Police observed graffiti with an anti-Israeli message in three locations across Strathfield.
12-Jan-25	A lifesaver observed a young person drawing swastikas and antisemitic symbols in the sand near surf safety flags, Cronulla Beach. The young person fled, continuing to draw similar symbols, and later returned to repeat the behaviour. While in custody, he scratched swastikas into his legs.
12-Jan-25	A male person was captured on CCTV painting a Nazi swastika symbol in gravy on the side wall of Chemist Warehouse, Hamilton.
13-Jan-25	An offender was observed performing a Nazi salute in public view. The offender resisted arrest attempting to barricade himself and physically obstruct officers.
13-Jan-25	Police were notified of antisemitic graffiti and two swastika symbols on brickwork along Railway Parade, Sydenham.
13-Jan-25	A hire bike displaying an Anti-Israeli slur was found approximately 100 meters from Newtown Synagogue.

13-Jan-25	A swastika was drawn on a wall in Crawford Place, which had already been painted over by maintenance workers. It was a communal residence with no ties to the Jewish community.
13-Jan-25	Anti-Israel and Pro-Palestine graffiti targeting a local business was discovered in the shared toilets in Byron Bay. CCTV shows two people entering the toilets who were identified on social media posting pro-Palestinian content and a picture of the vandalism. Due to prior cleaning and high foot traffic, no forensic examination was conducted.
13-Jan-25	A woman withdrew cash from an ATM, she discovered one note defaced with a swastika and a "Hitler moustache".
16-Jan-25	An anti-Israel, pro-Palestine sticker was found on a playground pole in Randwick.
17-Jan-25	Three masked men vandalized and set fire to vehicles and property at Military Road, Dover Heights, using red spray paint and an accelerant in a jerry can. Antisemitic and anti-Israel graffiti was sprayed on the cars, and they were set on fire.
17-Jan-25	A Jewish individual reported ongoing hate incidents since March 2024, involving verbal abuse and dangerous driving targeting her and her wife. The abuse escalated when the individual and their partner were seen wearing a Star of David. Someone made a Nazi gesture while shouting pro-Palestine remarks.
18-Jan-25	A young Caucasian male was escorted from a KFC in Sydney after performing a Nazi salute and shouting pro-Hitler phrases at patrons.
18-Jan-25	Bayside Council has received three reports from members of the public in relation to the anti-Israel graffiti.
19-Jan-25	An abandoned caravan located on Derriwong Road Dural containing explosives was reported to police.
20-Jan-25	Anti-Palestine graffiti targeting Muslims and Arabs was written on toilet doors at Hornsby Westfield. Similar incidents were previously reported at Chatswood and Burwood Westfield.
21-Jan-25	Someone parked in the driveway of a synagogue in Double Bay. When a witness attempted to enter the driveway, they delayed moving and, upon reversing, made an anti-Semitic remark and offensive gesture towards the witness.
21-Jan-25	A swastika graffiti was discovered on multiple Nationals Party campaign signs along Bathurst Road, Orange, including a large billboard and smaller signs near the IBIS Hotel and Kinross Mews.
21-Jan-25	Antisemitic graffiti reported.
21-Jan-25	Antisemitic, pro-German graffiti was discovered on a sign at St Andrews Cathedral Sydney, alongside a swastika. Similar graffiti on A4 papers were found at the school the previous day.
22-Jan-25	A fire broke out at a childcare centre in Maroubra, causing extensive damage. Anti-Semitic graffiti was found on the premises, though the centre has no Jewish affiliation.
22-Jan-25	A woman attempted to deposit approximately \$22,000 at Auburn ANZ when three \$50 notes were flagged by the machine. The notes contained anti-Semitic graffiti, including swastikas.

23-Jan-25	A sticker depicting Israeli President with the words "WANTED" and accusations of genocide and ecocide was found near the Sydney Cricket Ground.
23-Jan-25	Anti-Israel and antisemitic graffiti were reported in Meadowbank.
24-Jan-25	The word "NAZI" was carved into the toilet door at a cafe in Bellevue Hill.
24-Jan-25	Anti-Israel graffiti in pink lettering was found on corrugated fencing near a Newtown roundabout.
26-Jan-25	A man performed a Nazi salute near a Woolworths in Balmain. CCTV showed the individual making a fist pump while wearing a yellow armband with a Star of David.
26-Jan-25	Anti-Israel graffiti was discovered on a bike track near Towradgi Surf Club Park.
27-Jan-25	A Jewish individual was verbally abused by a rear passenger in a passing vehicle on Bondi Road, who shouted an anti-Semitic slur.
28-Jan-25	During a live news report outside Parliament House, a man shouted a pro-Nazi comment which was captured on air after he had directed indistinct comments and swearing at the reporter.
29-Jan-25	A member of parliament's office was vandalised on two separate occasions using black spray paint to write politically and religiously charged messages.
29-Jan-25	Anti-Semitic graffiti with a swastika was spray-painted on a garage wall in Eastlakes.
30-Jan-25	Two individuals wrote anti-Semitic graffiti across multiple locations in Maroubra and Westfield Eastgardens.
30-Jan-25	Swastikas and pro-Hitler phrases were found scratched into two gum trees in Gymea.
01-Feb-25	A male was trespassing and shouting anti-Semitic slurs outside a Jewish affiliated physiology service in Bondi. The man was seen on CCTV jumping fences, ringing the doorbell, and peering into windows.
	A man became aggressive at a mobile repair shop in Newtown during a dispute over phone repair pricing. He yelled at the staff, then threw a signage board, damaging the front desk. After briefly leaving, he returned to warn the victim not to call police before departing. Event not linked to Op Shelter.

06-Feb-25	A male was seen displaying a swastika flag to a secondary male, who photographed him and the flag. Incident occurred outside licensed premise in Darlinghurst.
06-Feb-25	A male was seen displaying a swastika flag to a secondary male, who photographed him and the flag. Incident occurred outside licensed premise in Darlinghurst.
06-Feb-25	Reported received of a Nazi swastika drawn in black permanent marker inside the pedestrian tunnel on Eddy Avenue, Haymarket.
09-Feb-25	An anonymous individual submitted an anti-Semitic message via the NSW Premier's web form. The message contained hate speech targeting Jewish people and referenced Nazi ideology.
10-Feb-25	Police responded to a report regarding anti-Semitic graffiti found in restricted areas of Chatswood Westfield.
10-Feb-25	A caller reported an anti-Semitic slogan vandalised on a fence in Nobbys Beach. Police found the message, which included swastikas and offensive language, written in permanent marker.
11-Feb-25	A takeaway food venue in Newtown reported feeling intimidated by four unknown individuals, one of whom claimed to be from the Daily Telegraph. The group included a man wearing Jewish symbols and others with cameras. The venue is known for its pro-Palestinian stance.
12-Feb-25	Viral video of two nurses engaging in online conversation and making antisemitic remarks whilst working within Bankstown Hospital.
12-Feb-25	Viral video of two nurses engaging in online conversation and making antisemitic remarks whilst working within Bankstown Hospital.

20-Feb-25	Police located extensive graffiti including anti-Semitic slurs, Nazi symbols, and offensive language in a restricted underpass area of Dulwich Hill.

21-Feb-25	Crime Stoppers report of swastika graffiti located at Eastwood Shopping Centre's openair carpark.

24-Feb-25	Male offender was found at a war memorial displaying Nazi swastikas and white supremacist slogans written on his body.
27-Feb-25	Electoral sign depicting the Federal member for Newcastle, Sharon CLAYDON MP was defaced with a swastika.
27-Feb-25	Swastika graffiti reported and located in Stairwell in Kings Cross.

28-Feb-25	Pro-Palestine graffiti reported on footpath in Meadowbank.
	Several reports of Pro-Palestine graffiti reported around Meadowbank area.
28-Feb-25	A doctor at St George Hospital was verbally targeted by a male who filmed and insulted him with anti-Semitic remarks. The doctor was wearing a Jewish identifiable cap at the time.
02-Mar-25	Swastika graffiti reported on the fence and bins of Pennant Hills business.
04-Mar-25	Police responded to a report of anti-Semitic graffiti in Sydney City local council area. Several antisemitic phrases depicted in the graffiti.
04-Mar-25	Anti-Semitic graffiti reading was discovered in a pedestrian tunnel on Eddy Avenue near Elizabeth Street, Haymarket.
05-Mar-25	An offender attended a club in Sydney accumulating a \$1,224 bill which he refused to pay. Police were called and tried to mediate, but the offender continued to refuse payment, used offensive language, mocked staff with racial accents, and made an anti-Semitic remark ("Heil Hitler").
07-Mar-25	Offensive anti-Semitic graffiti, including swastikas was discovered on a council bench in a public park near a playground and shopping village.
07-Mar-25	A Jewish assistant store manager at Woolworths was verbally abused by an unknown male who made anti-Semitic remarks.
07-Mar-25	Australian journalist received threatening and abusive messages after airing a report regarding Hezbollah supporters in Australia, including preacher Hussain Makke's planned speaking tour.
10-Mar-25	Hezbollah flags seized during search warrant.
10-Mar-25	Two persons vandalised the Newtown Synagogue with antisemitic graffiti and attempted arson, offenders spray-painted 10 red swastikas and a Z symbol on the synagogue's fence and poured accelerant and ignited a fire resulting in a small explosion.
	A witness observed antisemitic graffiti on a vehicle parked in Queens Park. The victim, who is not of Jewish faith, had parked the vehicle the previous morning without noticing any damage.
	Offenders graffitied the external wall of 36 Henry Street, Queens Park with antisemitic text and sprayed pink paint on nearby vehicles.
	Three offenders vandalised and set fire to vehicles and property in Dover Heights. They spray-painted antisemitic messages and ignited accelerant, destroying three vehicles and damaging nearby property. The location was previously owned by a prominent Jewish community leader.
	A fire broke out at a childcare centre in Maroubra, causing extensive damage to both floors of the building. Anti-Semitic graffiti was found on the premises, though the centre has no ties to the Jewish community

10-Mar-25	Three persons charged after participating in a criminal group targeting four locations with antisemitic graffiti. Offensive messages and swastikas were spray-painted at residential and public sites near Jewish institutions in Maroubra, Eastgardens, and Eastlakes.
12-Mar-25	A resident of Willoughby reported discovering a white swastika spray-painted on a skylight in his bedroom. The resident shares him residence with a unrelated business which occupies the lower levels of the property.
15-Mar-25	Police observed two males in John Mountford Reserve, Narwee. Spray paint was located nearby the males and Swastikas were seen spray painted.
15-Mar-25	Police observed two males in John Mountford Reserve, Narwee. Spray paint was located nearby the males and Swastikas were seen spray painted.
17-Mar-25	St Peter's Lutheran Church in Orange reported antisemitic graffiti. Four reversed white swastikas were found on the front door and wall.
19-Mar-25	Between May 2024 and March 2025, the NSW Jewish Board of Deputies received multiple unsolicited emails, while non-threatening, contained incoherent and persistent commentary critical of Israel and antisemitism discourse.
20-Mar-25	Anti-Israel graffiti located at Hurstville Westfield.
26-Mar-25	Police responded to a Crime Stoppers report of screaming and possible captives inside The Great Synagogue, Sydney. CSG confirmed no internal alarms were triggered and CCTV showed no suspicious activity. Report was confirmed to be vexatious.
