Page 66 of the transcript currently reads as:

LEON TAYLOR: We also have a number of ways our services and programs officers, who meet with <u>staff</u>, might become aware of an inmate's family member passing. They may be responsible for passing that information onto the inmate, so we become aware through the process of informing the inmate of a death in their family and then what flows from that are funeral arrangements that may be asked for.

This should be amended to:
