HEARING THIS WEEK INTO EMISSIONS FROM THE FOSSIL FUEL SECTOR

The NSW Parliament's Joint Standing Committee on Net Zero Future will meet this Friday 12 December for the first hearing for the inquiry into emissions from the fossil fuel industry in New South Wales.

This inquiry is examining emissions produced by the industries extracting coal and gas in New South Wales, including fugitive emissions, and those produced by associated infrastructure.

The Committee Chair, the Hon Jeremy Buckingham MLC, said: 'On Friday we will hear from the Net Zero Commission, concerned stakeholder groups, economic, scientific and legal experts as well as the mining industry, about emissions from mining and how these can be reduced, for the benefit of the people of New South Wales.'
