Thank you for your email.

I have reviewed the transcript and have the following comments that are highlighted in the attached document.

A missing apostrophe on page 13, (“...the lessor’s first response...”), highlighted in green on the page.

There is also what is either a mistype or I misspoke on the day. On page 13 it says ‘...and get accommodation where they really are in unstable accommodation.’ I think that first ‘accommodation’ was probably meant to be ‘an animal’ otherwise it doesn’t really make sense. If it’s what I said then I know it needs to stay that way, so I mention it just in case it was a typo. It’s also highlighted in green on the page.

On page 15 there’s potentially just an issue of syntax. The words highlighted in green on the page need a comma not a fullstop after ‘ADO’ ie ‘...even the little ADO, we hear from rescuers who are...[etc]’. In other words, the ADO is not at breaking point, but we do hear from rescuers...
