Committee to visit Wollongbar and Lismore for inquiry into vocational education and training

The parliamentary committee inquiring into vocational education and training in New South Wales will hold public hearings in Wollongbar and Lismore on 11 September 2015.

The committee will hear from a range of local stakeholders at these hearings, including TAFE teachers and students, representatives of the TAFE NSW North Coast Institute, private training providers, and local employers.

The chair of the committee, the Hon Paul Green MLC, said: “One of the key issues in this inquiry is the role played by public and private VET providers, including in the delivery of services to regional and rural communities. It is essential to hear from a wide range of local stakeholders so that the committee is informed about the issues facing regional communities when it comes to vocational education and training.”

The public hearings and public forum will take place at the following times and locations:

- The hearing in Wollongbar will be held at the Nightcap Restaurant, Wollongbar TAFE from 10.00 am until 12.00 pm.
- The hearing in Lismore will be held in Room A2.01 at Lismore TAFE from 2.00 pm until 4.15 pm.
