Dear Ms Simpson

I refer to the inquiry into Economic and Social Development in Central Western New South Wales recently held in Parkes and in particular to the Committee's question on notice concerning what proportion of farmers received exceptional circumstances interest rate subsidy (ECIRS) assistance in areas where the level of funding exceeded \$100 million for the period 2002 to 30 June 2011.

The five areas identified as receiving in excess of \$100 million are known formally as the Forbes, Murray, Narrandera, Riverina and Wagga Wagga Rural Lands Protection Board (RLPB) areas.

The NSW Rural Assistance Authority disbursed ECIRS to primary producers as defined by the policy guidelines applying to interest rate subsidies for areas affected by the exceptional circumstances provisions of the *Rural Adjustment Act 1992* (Cth) in these areas as follows:
