

**SUPPLEMENTARY QUESTIONS
To the Director of Public Prosecutions**

1. In your evidence (transcript page 11) you stated that the correspondence from the Ombudsman to you or your Office seeking advice on possible criminal charges arising from Operation Prospect did not refer to or mention Deputy Commissioner Kaldas by name or position. Will you provide the correspondence from the Ombudsman to this Committee?

Answer: The question is based on an incorrect premise. On page 11 I stated that the correspondence from me to the Attorney General on 12 December 2014 and February 2015 did not refer to Deputy Commissioner Kaldas by name. I attach those two letters. I ask that the correspondence be treated confidentially.

2. In your evidence (transcript page 10) you stated that you wrote to the previous Attorney General, Mr Hazzard, in November 2014 and February 2015 regarding the request for advice from the Ombudsman. Did that correspondence refer to or mention Deputy Commissioner Kaldas by name or position? Will you provide that correspondence to this Committee?

Answer: Correspondence attached. They are letters referred to in question 1 above. There was no mention of Deputy Commissioner Kaldas by name.

3. Did the correspondence received by you or your Office from Treasury refer to or mention Deputy Commissioner Kaldas by name or position?

Answer: No.

4. Will you provide that correspondence from Treasury to this Committee?

Answer: Attached. I ask that the correspondence be treated confidentially.

5. What was the money allocation by Treasury to the Office of the DPP for the provision of advice to the office of the Ombudsman regarding possible charges arising from Operation Prospect?

Answer: See Treasury letter referred to in question 4.

Answers to questions on notice

Page 11: The MOU was entered into on 6th May 2015.

Page 13: Attached are 2 letters from me to the Attorney General. As suggested by Mr Shoebridge at page 13, I ask that the correspondence be treated confidentially. (See letters as referred to in supplementary questions 1-2).

Page 14: No mention of the MOU in correspondence with the Attorney General.

Page 14: I asked Mr Mark Tedeschi QC whether he had leaked any information about receipt of a brief in Operation Prospect to the media. He answered, No I did not.

I asked Mr John Pickering SC whether he had leaked any information about receipt of a brief in Operation Prospect to the media. He answered, No I did not.

I emailed (as he is on leave) Mr Daniel Noll and asked whether he had leaked any information about receipt of a brief in Operation Prospect to the media. He answered, No I did not.
