

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ARISING OUT OF THE ABORIGINAL AFFAIRS BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING OF 28 AUGUST, 2006

Can you tell me about No More, the group program for adolescent young men who have alcohol-related violence issues. An evaluation of this program has been found to be effective in assisting the target group. Can you tell us where the No More program is at the moment?

ANSWER:

'No more grog: No more shame: No more hurt: No more pain: NO MORE' was developed in a partnership between the Daruk Aboriginal community and the Department of Juvenile Justice over a two year period in the late 1990s. It aims to address the issue of alcohol related violence for adolescent males before they become entrenched.

The Department of Aboriginal Affairs has not been involved in the development or administration and implementation of this program. The details about this program are best obtained from the Department of Juvenile Justice.
