Re: Question on Notice

I refer to your letter, dated 31 August 2006, relating to a question taken on notice during the budget estimates hearing on 28 August 2006.

In response to the question asked by the Hon Don Harwin MLC, I am pleased to advise as follows:

Question asked: Could you outline what the rent is for each ministerial office?

Response: Ministers have been charged rent for office accommodation at Parliament House since the 1999/2000 financial year. The rent payable by each minister for the 2006/07 financial year is set out on the attachment to this letter. A total of \$825,522.75 will be payable by ministers, and the Director-General of The Cabinet Office, in 2006/07.
