Questions taken on notice after the hearing

GAMING AND RACING

Gaming machine Smartcard Technology (questions 1 – 3)

Minister McKay acting on your behalf stated a discussion on pre commitment technology for gaming machines was exactly the sort of conversation that we've been looking forward to having with the federal government" in response to Julia Gillard's commitment to Andrew Wilkie on "precommitment technology" for gaming machines was ":

1. Have you or anyone else from the Government had dialogue with the Federal Government in regard to the proposed changes?
2. What effect do you think this will have on clubs and hotels in NSW?
3. In your opinion do you think the introduction of 'pre-commitment technology' will reduce problem gambling?
 - a) Why/why not?

Answers:

1. It is my understanding that these matters will be discussed at a COAG select minister's council in due course.
2. The effect of smartcard technology on clubs and hotels will be dependent on the details of any model agreed to be adopted.
3. It would depend on the details of any model agreed to be adopted.

Gambling Help Website (questions 4 – 15)

4. How many people have visited the Gambling Help (www.gamblinghelp.nsw.gov.au) website since it's launch online?
5. How many people have used the online counselling service on the website?
6. How many people have used the Gambling Help phone service as a result of the website?
7. How many people subscribed to the free SMS reminder service?
8. How many times has the online gambling workbook been downloaded?
9. How many copies were distributed via mail?
10. Of the 11 available free print materials listed how many copies of each of these publications were ordered?
11. How much did each of these publications cost to produce?
12. How much did the website cost to produce?
13. Has this website been advertised?
14. If so, through what means?
15. How much did it cost to advertise and raise awareness of the Gambling Help website?

Answers:

4. Since 1 July 2008, www.gamblinghelp.nsw.gov.au has attracted 43,129 visits (as at 27 September 2010).
5. The NSW Gambling Help website is the second most common source of referral for Gambling Help Online, after the www.problemgambling.vic.gov.au website. From 31 August 2009 to 30 June 2010, 782 individuals sought counselling by clicking through from the NSW Gambling Help site.

The 2009/10 Gambling Help Online annual report indicates that from the time of the launch on 31 August 2009 to 30 June 2010, the site attracted:

- 9,778 unique visitors
- 1,051 clients who were directly engaged by online counselling personnel

- 110 unique email support requests, resulting in a further 385 email exchanges between counsellor and client.

6. While the Gambling Helpline (1800 858 858) collects data on where callers learned about the service, this data is based on broad categories rather than identifying individual websites.

However, service reports indicate that target calls to Gambling Help in August 2010, the month when Year 2 of the campaign was launched, increased by 25% compared to July 2010.

7. 2,080 people have subscribed to the free SMS reminder service (as at 27 September 2010).

8. 1,735 copies of the gambling workbook have been downloaded (as at 27 September 2010).

9. More than 4,000 workbooks have been distributed.

10. The quantities of each publication ordered (through various sources - not limited to website orders) include:

- More than 70,000 Gambling Help brochures.
- 4,000 Gambling Help posters.
- More than 1,500 copies of the *Gaming Machines: Facts and Myths* DVD.
- 4,000 workbooks.
- 3,000 copies of *A Guide to Problem Gambling: Children and Young People*.
- 500 copies of the *Pocket Guide to a Skilled Workforce: Problem Gambling Counselling*.
- 2,760 multi-language gambling help posters (promoting Gambling Help services in English and five other languages).
- 24,650 fold-out z-cards (in Chinese, Greek, Vietnamese, Arabic, Italian).

11. The amounts spent to date (as of 30 September 2010) on producing these publications are as follows:

- Production of Gambling Help promotional materials - \$30,445.

- CALD material production - \$41,670.
- Gambling workbook - \$6,470.
- *Gaming Machines: Facts and Myths* DVD (for production in English and for translation into Italian, Greek, Chinese, Vietnamese and Arabic) - \$52,510.
- *A Guide to Problem Gambling: Children and Young People* - \$31,400.
- *A Pocket Guide to a Skilled Workforce: Problem Gambling Counselling* - \$3,290.

14. Yes, the site is promoted in all communications including posters, brochures, signage and advertising – print and online. It has also been promoted online through various web sites and social media channels such as Facebook.
15. No funds were specifically directed towards advertising the website. Promotion of the Gambling Help website is achieved as a component of the overall awareness raising activities of the Responsible Gaming Fund.

Proceeds of sale of New South Wales Lotteries

Given that in your second reading speech for the NSW Lotteries Authorised Transaction Bill 2009 you on June 3, 2009; you stated that:

The bill will allow taxpayer resources currently locked up in NSW Lotteries to be redirected to community priorities such as health, education and roads. The bill will ensure that net proceeds from this transaction will be transferred directly to the Consolidated Fund, to support the Government's ongoing commitment to important social infrastructure.

The Bill will ensure net proceeds from this transaction will be transferred directly to the Consolidated Fund to support the Government's ongoing commitment to important social infrastructure.

16. Will you admit that both of you misled the public given that \$510 million was put into the public service superannuation fund?

OLGR Liquor Compliance Audits

17. How many compliance audits' were done on-site for each year since 2000?
18. How many compliance audits were conducted over the phone since 2000?
19. How many breaches were recorded after on-site inspections for year since 2000?
20. How many breaches were recorded after audits were conducted over the phone for each year since 2000?
21. Which venues have recorded licensing breaches thus far in 2010?
22. On April 21, 2010 Scott Weber asked in the Sydney Morning Herald in an article titled 'Liquor prosecutions on the wane', Who ordered the OLGR to wind back its compliance activities and why?', are you able to answer this question?
23. If you did not issue a directive to wind back compliance activities who did?

Answers:

17. In the year 2000-695, 2001-968, 2002-3721, 2003-5519, 2004-2080, 2005-2598. Due to database limitations, on-site and phone audit data for the years 2006, 2007 and 2008 were combined. Combined audits for these years were 2006-14659, 2007-10932, 2008-9714. On-site audits for the remainder of the requested period were 2009-2161, 2010-2313.
18. In the years 2000 through 2002, telephone audits were not recorded. In 2003-503, 2004-1317, 2005-2948. As detailed in the response to question 17, due to database limitations on-site and phone audit data for the years 2006, 2007 and 2008 were combined (see the above answer for the combined audit figures for these years). Telephone audits for the remainder of the requested period were 2009-8627, 2010-695.

20. From 2000 through 2008 database restrictions prevented breaches being sorted by telephone or on-site type. The combined breaches for onsite and telephone audits commencing the year 2000 are 2000-3527, 2001-465, 2002-1751, 2003-2342, 2004-2725, 2005-4820, 2006-11041, 2007-10410, 2008-7192. For the years 2009 and 2010 the following on-site audit breaches were recorded: 2009-3123, 2010-

5314. For the years 2009 and 2010 the following telephone audit breaches were recorded: 2009-293, 2010-795.

22. I am aware of the Scott Webber article and yes I can answer the question. There have been no orders or directives to OLGR to wind back its compliance activities. The reality is most licensees do the right thing. Therefore, OLGR have directed greater regulatory and enforcement effort at addressing the small number of high risk venues, that is, those with the highest incident levels of assault and associated violent crime. This focussed and in-depth approach, while reducing the overall number of inspections, has resulted in significant state-wide reductions in alcohol related crime.
23. No such directive was issued.

Racing

24. Minister, do you have any plans to arrest the erosion of wagering revenues to the Racing Industry caused by the proliferation of Interstate corporate on-line bookmakers and betting exchanges?
25. Do you endorse the direction of the Racing NSW Strategic Plan, which seems to rely, on the revenue side, entirely on the success of Racefields legislation in Court?
26. Would you have liked to see a more diversified strategy to regain these lost revenues?
27. Do you endorse the selection of certain country racecourses as training centres of excellence?
28. How will you explain to clubs not so selected that they are slated to be allowed to decline and even disappear because of a policy of "picking winners and losers" that the Plan entails?

Answer:

24. The Government's racing policy includes provision of a legislative and Government framework that promotes future viability of the racing industry.

The Race Fields legislation introduced in 2008 operates on the principle that all wagering operators that use New South Wales race fields for profit, irrespective of their location, should pay a fair price to the New South Wales racing industry.

Under the race fields scheme, a wagering operator wishing to use NSW race fields is required to apply to the relevant controlling body of racing for approval. Such approval may be subject to conditions, including the payment of a fee.

I am advised that under these arrangements, as at 30 June 2010 in the order of \$90 million had been collected by the NSW controlling bodies of racing.

The Government has defended the Constitutional challenges against its race fields laws before the Federal Court. It intervened in the challenge by Tasmanian based betting exchange operator, Betfair, over the application of the race fields legislation by Racing NSW and Harness Racing NSW and was a respondent in a challenge by

Northern Territory licensed bookmaker, Sportsbet, over the validity of the legislation. Sportsbet also challenged the application of the legislation by Racing NSW and Harness Racing NSW.

The decisions in these proceedings were handed down by Justice Perram in the Federal Court on 16 June 2010.

One of the most important findings was that the New South Wales race fields laws are valid. This establishes a sound basis for the future operation of the scheme and collection of race fields fees.

There were other findings which found the race fields approvals granted by Racing NSW and Harness Racing NSW to Sportsbet to be invalid for reasons that they breached section 92 of the Constitution.

Appeal proceedings involving the legislation and the administration of the Race Fields scheme are before the Full Court of the Federal Court and a judgment is anticipated shortly. It is not appropriate to comment further on these proceedings at this time.

The Government is committed to the race fields legislation and the principle that all wagering operators, whether intra state or interstate, should pay their way and provide fair compensation to the racing industry.

25. The fees from race fields are one source of revenue identified in the Strategic Plan. They broaden the thoroughbred industry's overall revenue base.

While these fees will clearly play an important role in ensuring the ongoing viability of the industry, the Plan does not, as the question suggests, place total reliance on revenue from this source.

26. See answer above.

28. The control and regulation of racing in NSW is the responsibility of the three controlling bodies of racing. These bodies are independent of Government and are not subject to Government direction.

A part of their function is to make decisions about the allocation of race dates and resources for the purpose of optimising the future viability of the racing industry. There is a statutory duty that they must do so in the best interests of their respective code of racing.
