3. What role has Aboriginal Affairs NSW played in the Aboriginal Resources and Pathways Project and the ADHC Aboriginal Policy Framework?
4. What is the funding allocation for the Family Records Unit in the current budget?
5. Will the Minister outline some the projects undertaken in the last financial year under the Aboriginal Communities Development Program and how the \$5.3 million allocated to the program in the budget will be spent?
