The Hon. JOHN ROBERTSON: I will take it on notice and come back to you.


Answer:

I understand that it is not proposed to stage the delivery of the project. I am advised that the capital cost estimate for the entire North West Rail Link from Epping to Rouse Hill is \$6.7 billion.

Additionally, quadruplication of the North Shore Line between Chatswood and St Leonards is estimated at \$700 million and extra stabling at \$140 million.

The Hon. JOHN ROBERTSON: I will take it on notice and come back to you.


Answer:




The Hon. JOHN ROBERTSON: I will take it on notice.

CHAIR: You do not know off the top of your head where all that money is coming from?




I am advised that the major milestones of the delivery timetable for the electronic ticketing system program are:

2 nd half 2013	Begin rollout of electronic ticketing system on government and private bus networks

Question:

Ms CATE FAEHRMANN: When the Federal Government announced its support for the Parramatta to Epping project at a cost of \$2.1 billion, did it review the State Government's project costings or did it simply accept them?

The Hon. JOHN ROBERTSON: You would have to ask the Commonwealth Government what it did or did not do. As I said, we have been having a dialogue. I cannot answer for what the Commonwealth did or did not do.

Ms CATE FAEHRMANN: Do you have an estimate for land acquisition costs?

Mr WIELINGA: We will have to take that question on notice. As I said earlier, they are not included in the \$2.6 billion. We need to continue the review work and the land acquisition costs will have to be reconsidered again as part of that process.

Answer:

The project will go through a rigorous planning and development phase which will refine the scope and capital costs of all elements of the project.

Funding the project will be a combination of Commonwealth and State contributions. The State's contribution is within the \$50.2 billion Metropolitan Transport Plan budget.
