- 1. Events NSW
 - a. How much is the retainer paid to Events NSW Chairman Mr John O'Neill by the NSW Government?
 - b. How much is the retainer paid to Events NSW CEO Mr Geoff Parmenter by the NSW Government?
 - c. Are Mr John O'Neill and Mr Geoff Parmenter subject to Key Performance Indicators? If so, what are they?
- 2. Cruise Industry
 - a. Planning Minister Kristina Keneally stated that the cruise ship terminal would be relocated to White Bay for a minimum of 5 years. As Minister for Tourism do you think this is acceptable?
 - b. As Minister for Tourism do you think that the White Bay facility itself gives overseas and interstate tourists a good first impression of Sydney?
 - c. Do you think this debacle is a result of 'short sightedness' on the part of the Minister for Ports and Waterways?
 - d. If not, how do you think this problem came about?
- 3. Events
 - a. In June of this year, Ashley Spencer, vice-president of Hilton Hotel's Australasian operations stated that "We (Sydney) should be hosting much more international conventions and sporting events that Melbourne is taking". What initiatives has your department implemented to attract such events?
