Please accept our sincerest apologies for not having responded to the Committee's questions by 13 December 2013 as requested. We only recently became aware of the Committee's request for information.

As we understand it, the Committee has asked two questions:

- What is the number of dogs (beyond just greyhounds) that are euthanised in New South Wales per year (pages 61 and 62, attached)? Our answer is: in 2010/2011, the number was 21,670 (source: Companion Animals Taskforce, Discussion Paper, May 2012, page 58: http://www.dlq.nsw.gov.au/dlg/dlghome/documents/Information/Companion%20Animals%20Taskforce%20Discus sion%20Paper%20May%202012.pdf). The statistics for more recent years are not available to us. However, we understand that the Division of Local Government (DLG) collects data on euthanasia rates, and may be able to provide data for more recent years. - What is the statistical break-up of animals euthanised by the Animal Welfare League NSW (AWL NSW), by reason for euthanasia (page 68, attached)? Our answer appears below.

Death in foster care

We have on record an unassisted death of a greyhound in April 2013. The greyhound had come into our shelters and was placed in foster care, after which the animal died.
