The Hon. GREG PEARCE: What happened to the suggestion by former Premier Rees that he would save \$200 million a year from the public sector payroll through restructuring and a staff freeze? Has that been delivered?

Mr RAPER: I would have to take that on notice. I have only been in this position since 17 February and Mr Rees was not the Premier at the time.

ANSWER

On 11 November 2008 former Premier Rees announced Government would cut the size of the Senior Executive Service by 20%, with 171 top level jobs to go and saving \$119 million over four years. This cut was achieved.

Former Premier Rees also announced a staff freeze on the recruitment of all non-frontline public servants until the end of June 2009. This freeze was put in place and is ongoing.
