

### CRIMES (FORENSIC PROCEDURES) ACT 2000 - SECT 93

#### Permissible matching of DNA profiles

#### 93 Permissible matching of DNA profiles

- (1) A matching of a DNA profile on an index of the <u>DNA database system</u> specified at the top of a column of the table to this subsection with a DNA profile on an index of the system specified in column 1 of a row of the table:
- (a) is not permitted by this Part if "no" is shown at the intersection of the relevant row and column, and
- (b) is permitted by this Part if "yes" is shown at the intersection of the relevant row and column, and
- (c) is permitted by this Part in connection with the <u>volunteers</u> (limited purposes) index if "only if within purpose" is shown at the intersection of the relevant row and column, but only if the matching is for a purpose for which the relevant DNA profile was placed on that index.

(3) A person:

Maximum penalty: 100 penalty units or imprisonment for 2 years, or both.

<sup>(</sup>a) whose conduct gives rise to a matching that is not permitted by this Part of a DNA profile on an index of the <u>DNA database</u> system with a DNA profile on the same or another index of the DNA database system, and

<sup>(</sup>b) who intends or is reckless as to any such matching of profiles, is guilty of an offence.

<sup>(4)</sup> This section does not make it an offence for conduct to cause a matching that is not permitted by this Part if the matching is solely for the purpose of administering the <u>DNA database system</u>.
