1. there have been 24 overnight stays by large cruise ships at the White Bay terminal site or the next wharf in the last 12 months. We have been informed that the number of ships accessing this terminal will double next year and then keep going up , almost exponentially. In these circumstances we could expect the number of nights ships stay over could also double next year.

2. Yes our community and Council are aware of the nuisance tort provisions, but we and they should not have to pursue such action, as it is absolutely clear that alleviating the severe toxicity, health and psychosocial ill-effects are squarely the responsibilities of the NSW state government, rather than the local community or the municipal council. This is already accepted by all the government departments attending the 8 weekly interdepartmental meetings.
