## State Election 2007

Parties	<ul> <li>RPP's disclose every four years following a state general election.</li> <li>Disclosure period starts on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2007.</li> </ul>
Donors	<ul> <li>Disclose every four years following a state general election.</li> <li>Disclosure period starts on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2007.</li> <li>By-Elections</li> <li>If a donor donates more than \$1500 for a state by-election they also have to disclose following the by-election.</li> <li>Disclosure period starts on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the by-election.</li> </ul>
Groups	<ul> <li>Disclose following the state general election.</li> <li>Disclosure period starts on nomination day for the 2007 general election and finishes on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2007.</li> </ul>
Candidates who contested the 2003 SGE	<ul> <li>Disclosure period starts on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2007.</li> </ul>
Candidates who contested a by-election since the 2003 SGE	<ul> <li>Disclosure period starts on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after the by-election and finishes on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2007.</li> </ul>

Candidates who contested the 2004 LGE	Disclosure period starts on the 31 <sup>st</sup> day after the previous general election in 2004 and finishes on the 30 <sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2008.
Candidates who contested a by-election or deferred election since the 2004 LGE	Disclosure period starts on the 31 <sup>st</sup> day after the by-election or deferred election and finishes on the 30 <sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2008.
All other candidates	Disclosure period starts 12 months before nomination day for the 2008 general election and finishes on the 30 <sup>th</sup> day after the general election in 2008.
