State Election 2007

Parties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> RPP's disclose every four years following a state general election. Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2007.
Donors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Disclose every four years following a state general election. Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2007. <p>By-Elections</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If a donor donates more than \$1500 for a state by-election they also have to disclose following the by-election. Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30th day after the by-election.
Groups	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Disclose following the state general election. Disclosure period starts on nomination day for the 2007 general election and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2007.
Candidates who contested the 2003 SGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the previous general election in 2003 and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2007.
Candidates who contested a by-election since the 2003 SGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the by-election and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2007.
All other candidates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Disclosure period starts 12 months before nomination day for the 2007 general election and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2007.

Local Government Election 2008

Parties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> RPP's disclose every four years following a Local Government general election. Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the previous general election in 2004 and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2008.

Candidates who contested the 2004 LGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the previous general election in 2004 and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2008.
Candidates who contested a by-election or deferred election since the 2004 LGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disclosure period starts on the 31st day after the by-election or deferred election and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2008.
All other candidates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disclosure period starts 12 months before nomination day for the 2008 general election and finishes on the 30th day after the general election in 2008.
