## **INQUIRY INTO ELECTORAL AND POLITICAL PARTY FUNDING**

### **Public Forum**

The Select Committee on Electoral and Political Party Funding will hold a public forum on Friday 4 April 2008.

“Campaign funding, and in particular the vexed issue of developer donations, is clearly of great concern to the people of NSW. To date this Committee has received over 170 submissions, with more arriving every day,” Committee Chairman Revd Fred Nile said.

“The Committee looks forward to hearing from the community on this important issue.”

The forum will be held at Parliament House from 6 to 8pm on Friday 4 April 2008.

All members of the public are encouraged to attend or speak at the forum. The Committee will write to all individuals who have made submissions, to invite them to speak at the forum.

The opinions stated at the forum will inform the Committee’s report and recommendations.
