I am writing to you about the station access fee at Sydney Airport.

I am a pilot, I live in Surry Hills so the train is the fastest way for me to get to work. However I refuse to pay the exorbitant station fee. At over 30\$ per return trip its just too expensive so I drive.

I used to live in Queensland, the Brisbane airport train charges a similar fee, 30\$ return from Brisbane airport to the city, over a similar distance.

However airport employess can purchase a book of 20 tickets for 100\$, reducing the cost to 5\$ per trip.

I have tried to contact city rail about 3 times regarding this, but have never had a reply. I also believe that some employee groups at the airport have been trying for a similar system but nothing has been achieved.

Getting the station access fee may be hatd to get removed, but surely an airport employee voucher system reducing the cost to 5\$ one way could be set up. This would have huge savings in car trips to the airport, road congestion etc.

Weekly Ticket - \$30.00

The weekly paper ticket allows you unlimited travel between the Brisbane Airport and city stations for a 7 day period.

Book of 20 Tickets - \$110.00

These tickets are ideal for shift workers and others that don't work at the airport every weekday.

You must have a valid ticket each time you travel on the train, and present this with your Staff ID card when entering and exiting the train station. Tickets are non-refundable and cannot be used by another person. The employment letter is required to be updated every 12 months or on request by Airtrain.
