There should be an immediate upgrade of the bus system in the North West

1. A network of dedicated bus high speed bus lanes and transit ways that run into the cbd (in addition to the mainly radial network that exists now)

2. Fix the existing system so it works better eg

Prebuy tickets (newsagents etc) the existing pay as you get on (Hillsbus) is hopelessly sloww and clogs the whole network

3. Make buses and timetables connect. Keep high speed buses on main routes and slower (smaller) feeder buses to pick up through suburbs

4. Have more parking areas for high speed main bus routes

5. Open the breakdown lane on M2 for buses. Create a bicycle lane off the main road where the nature strip is (but make it suitable for fast commute bikers)
