The Physio said his chair is the wrong type and he need one that has a head rest so his chest is open and he can get air into his lungs.

I have been telling the OT's that he has the wrong chair but they know best and all these years wasted.

Hope this is of use to you and I am very sorry for the delay.

Again, thank you for providing the opportunity to make a submission to the Inquiry into the NSW PADP; I trust that these issues above will be given serious consideration and that the inquiry results in a positive outcome.
