I am concerned by the threat to terminate the Hunter Line at Wickham and the Central Coast Line at Broadmeadow. The present interchange at Hamilton provides a vital link for anyone doing anything in Sydney and returning the same day. It is the only way of arriving in Sydney before mid-day for anyone on the Hunter Line (visa applications in particular). The time available in Sydney was reduced by half an hour recently and there had been pressure for more services. The service is also widely used by people travelling with luggage and a double change, possibly involving a bus, would be extremely inconvenient.
