As the business operator in the Lane Cove West Business Park, we hereby object to the proposed design changes to Epping Road, as part of the Lane Cove tunnel project.

Kastle Systems Australia employees 26 persons and we have been operating in the Lane Cove West Business Park for 18 years.

The proposed narrowing of Epping Road to one lane in the vicinity of Sam Johnson Way would have a catastrophic impact on the access to Lane Cove West Business Park and will impose an adverse impact on our business.

We request that redesign of Epping Road maintain a minimum of two (2) lanes in each direction and that the capacity of the intersection with Sam Johnson Way be designed to facilitate the adequate flow of traffic necessitating access and egress to Lane Cove West Business Park.
