I couldn't have afforded much anyway-I was on Barista's wages. I also completed my Certificate 4 in training and assessment at TAFE and it led to me getting work as an ESOL teacher at Newcastle TAFE which I am very grateful for.

My story is one of hundreds of thousands. A lot of my mates did their trades at TAFE, or their HSC because they didn't finish school-TAFE was their second chance because it was affordable.

Please don't let this government destroy TAFE-the social impact will be felt for generations to come, and it may not be recoverable.



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
