## INQUIRY INTO RECREATIONAL FISHING

I wish to make the following submission with regard to the Inquiry into Recreational Fishing.

It is essential that recreational fishing be managed in a responsible and balanced manner.

Representatives from the recreational fishing community must be involved in the decision making process to achieve this balance. Consultation and communication with the community must also be a part of the process.
