The dreadful conditions they are subjected to the isolation and lack of socialisation to other breeds that can make their lives more difficult when rehomed after the end of their racing careers. Not enogh is being done to rehome greyhounds in Australia I also know that greyhounds are exported from Australia to the canidrome of Macau China those poor greyhounds are kept in absolutely horrid and nightmarish conditions and I think its high time that attitudes towards greyhounds as mere bargaining chips was altered for good. I love my four greyhounds and there will always be greyhounds in my home.
