As a local resident and parent of a child at Balmain Public School, I have concerns about the effect on local air quality of cruise ships docking at White Bay. I believe that Sydney Harbour regulations on fuel use should mirror the established practices in the northern hemisphere and restrict the sulphur content of fuel to 0.1% to minimise risk to our community.

It is also imperative that a ship to shore power link be mandatory, to negate the use of ships engines while docked.
