Relevance/Terms of Reference: The capability and performance of Greyhound Racing NSW and governance of the industry

What I would like to say:

- I think the TAB Distribution is unfair to the greyhound industry and should be changed to a fairer system. The last government commissioned a report (Cameron Report) and did not implement the two most important recommendations (21 and 22). The Racing Minister at the time is now on the board of Thoroughbred Racing NSW and is a life member of the ATC.
- I am not happy with the mismanagement at GRNSW. I believe the number of staff is excessive for the amount of work they do (there are less participants now than when GRNSW started).
- I am not happy with the amount of greyhound industry funds that were poured into the Gardens complex and believe that the money has been mismanaged and wasted.
